

A Stewardship Moment

This weekend we participate in the proclamation of the passion and death of Jesus according to the Gospel of Mark. In the extended version of this weekend's Gospel reading, Jesus is at Gethsemane, praying to his Father, in much emotional distress. He knows he can save himself. He can escape over the Mount of Olives in the dead of night and make his way safely into the Judean desert. Instead, Jesus chooses obedience to his Father and waits for his persecutors. As Saint Paul puts it in the second reading, Jesus is "obedient to the point of death." Jesus' obedience is a lesson for those who are good stewards of their life in Christ. Let us reflect on how we might be more obedient to the will of God instead of our own will.

CCD Registration-2024-2025 Registration for the next CCD Year has started.

Registration Forms were handed out to parents in the drop off line last week of currently registered and attending students. The Registration Form can also be found on the church website @stbasiljudice.org and hard copies are also available at the entrance of church in the shelf in the second to last cubby.

-Parents of 1st-10th Graders need to fill out & mail in the registration forms by the due date of April 30,2024. The due date gives us time to order materials needed and have volunteer teachers in place for the number of students who register for next year's program.

-Parents of students entering 1st Grade...a copy of the child's BAPTISM CERTIFI-CATE must accompany the registration form & payment for the registration process to be completed.

-Parents entering a student in the program as a 2nd-10th Grader who is New to the program must have a copy of the child's BAPTISM & COMMUNION CERTIFI-CATE and CCD Records or a letter from the DRE/Religion Coordinator from the church parish your child attended previously is also required. The certificates and records should accompany the registration form & payment for the registration process to be completed.
