

PROCEDURE: In the Sacristy there will be a purple suitcase with the following items inside:

The Statue, a handmade crochet table cover, a gold crown (very fragile, so please handle with care), a Rosary to hang from her hands, and a little dove for the hole in the front bottom of the statue...ten blessed Rosaries, ten "How to Pray the Rosary" pamphlets, some pamphlets on the First Saturday devotion, and a book on the Fatima apparition of Mary to the three children.

Pick up the suitcase when you come to Mass, then return it by the next Saturday 4 PM Mass for the next pick-up.

2024-2025 Potential Confirmation Candidates: Sessions start August 12th. Attention Catholic School & Public School 9th & 10th Graders for the upcoming school year!

St. Basil is in the 2nd year of the "3 Year Diocesan Transitioning Plan of Confirmation" and this includes Public and Catholic school students in 9th & 10th Grade for the upcoming school year for your parish. If you are planning to make the Sacrament of Confirmation with St. Basil this yeat and have NOT filled out a CCD registration form, please do so as soon as possible.
